Discussion Licensing Requirements for Vessel and Individual Limits

Andrew Button, Deputy Chief, Shellfish Management Division, reviewed the licensing and limit regulations. His comments are a part of the verbatim record.

- One user fee and gear license = 11imit
- Vessel limits unchanged from last year, 28 hand or hand tong, 16 PT, HS, DR.
- Vessels and individuals shall only use one type of gear in the public fishery on any single day.
- The person 'working' the gear does not have to hold a license or user fee, but a user fee and license holder must be on the vessel.
- 'By Hand' harvest must be undertaken by the license holder

Member Kellum made a motion to approve the license and vessel requirements as presented. Member seconded Mason the motion. Motion passed 10-0.

<u>Discussion on the 2023-24 Public Oyster Harvest Season and Request for SMAC</u> Recommendation
