2. We will solicit local tackle shops and businesses for donations but will still need your help to make this project a success.
3. Members of the NCAC will provide transportation for the children not able to secure their own.
4. We get good press coverage which stimulates interest and competition in the event.
5. The project is a community affair as well because we invite the parents of the children to enjoy the picnic with them after the fishing trip.
6. As a result of our past programs, the Northampton County Middle School now has an active "FISHING CLUB" with a waiting list for new members.
7. We reward the children with prizes and give them tackle that they may keep as their own.
8. We teach the children conservation and the value of our natural resources - our goal is to "get the children hooked on something good and maybe they won't get hooked on something bad".
