TO: ATLANTIC CROAKER AND SPOT HARVESTERS AND BUYERS FROM: VIRGINIA MARINE RESOURCES COMMISSION RE: COMMERCIAL SEASONS FOR ATLANTIC CROAKER AND SPOT

Effective 12:01 A.M., Thursday, April 15, 2021, two new regulations for Atlantic croaker and spot are established for the Commonwealth. These regulations include the implementation of commercial seasons. The new commercial seasons for these two species are as follows:

Atlantic croaker: January 15 - December 31 of any calendar year Spot: April 15 - December 8 of any calendar year

We recognize that the restrictions on the start of the seasons have passed for the current calendar year. The commercial spot season will close December 8, 2021, while opening dates for both species will go into effect in 2022.

Chapter 4 VAC 20-1370-10 et seq., "Pertaining to Atlantic Croaker", states the following: 4 VAC 20-1370-50. COMMERCIAL FISHERY.

It shall be unlawful for any person fishing commercially with any gear type to harvest or land any Atlantic croaker before January 15 of the current calendar year.

Chapter 4 VAC 20-1380-10 et seq., "Pertaining to Spot", states the following: 4 VAC 20-1380-50. COMMERCIAL FISHERY. It shall be unlawful for any person fishing commercially with any gear type to harvest or land any spot before April 15 or after December 8 of the current calendar year.
