SUBJECT: OPENING OF VIRGINIA'S 2026 DIRECTED OFFSHORE SUMMER FLOUNDER FISHERY

2026 Fall/Winter Openings

- **Fall/Winter 2026, Virginia will open its Directed Offshore Summer Flounder Fishery for 2 periods. The open dates and landing limits are as follows:**
 - The landing limit for the Offshore (EEZ) Fishery from Thursday, October 1 through Sunday, November 15, 2026, is 12,500 pounds. Vessels may land a maximum of 12,500 pounds for the entire period of October 1 through November 15, 2026.
 - The landing limit for the Offshore (EEZ) Fishery from Monday, November 16 through Thursday, December 31, 2026, is 12,500 pounds. Vessels may land a maximum of 12,500 pounds for the entire period of November 16 through December 31, 2026.
- **During the open Directed Offshore Summer Flounder Fishery periods, each vessel shall hold a Virginia Summer Flounder Endorsement License and adhere to the below restrictions:**
- It shall be unlawful for any vessel to land in Virginia any amount of summer flounder more than once in any consecutive 5-day period.
- It shall be unlawful to possess aboard any vessel in Virginia waters any amount of summer flounder in excess of the total of the Virginia landing limit (12,500 pounds) and the amount of the legal North Carolina or New Jersey landing limit or trip limit.

- It shall be unlawful for any person to possess aboard any vessel, in Virginia, any amount of summer flounder, once it has been projected and announced that 100% of the quota described in 4VAC20-620-30 A has been taken.
