TO: SPINY DOGFISH STATE PERMIT HOLDERS

FROM: VIRGINIA MARINE RESOURCES COMMISSION

RE: SPINY DOGFISH OVERNIGHT GILLNET PROHIBITION


On July 22, 2025, the Virginia Marine Resources Commission voted to amend Chapter 4VAC 20-490, "Pertaining to Sharks". This language amendment takes the place of the amendment that was passed on April 22, 2025.

Chapter 4 VAC 20-490-42. Spiny dogfish commercial quota and harvest limitations. "It shall be unlawful for any person possessing a Virginia Spiny Dogfish Permit to leave any gill net gear with a mesh size equal to or greater than 5.25- inches and less than 10- inches in the Delaware and Maryland Atlantic Sturgeon Bycatch Reduction Area or the Virginia Atlantic Sturgeon Bycatch Reduction Area between 8:00 pm through 5:00 am the following day from November 1 through March 31."

These reduction areas are defined as:
