## RE: CLOSURE OF THE 2023 VIRGINIA HORSESHOE CRAB GENERAL HARVEST CATEGORY FISHERY EFFECTIVE 12 MIDNIGHT, TUESDAY, MAY <sup>2nd</sup>, 2023.

Effective 12 Midnight, Tuesday, May <sup>2nd</sup>, 2023, the Virginia horseshoe crab general harvest commercial fishery will close. Based upon landing reports from Virginia seafood buyers and horseshoe crab harvesters, it is projected that Virginia will have harvested 100% of the horseshoe crab general category quota allocated to be harvested by Virginia Horseshoe Crab General Category Permittees by the above date and time.

Therefore, after 12 midnight, Tuesday, May <sup>2nd</sup>, 2023, the possession or landing of any horseshoe crabs in Virginia by any gear type except trawl, pound net, dredge, or hand harvest shall be prohibited (Chapter 4 VAC 20-900-10 et seq.).
