DESCRIPTIVE TITLE OF PROJECT: Fifth Annual VCBA Youth Fishing Adventure Day							
PROJECT SUMMARY: The day starts with detailed educational topics taught by the individual Boat Captains. The topics will include one or more of the following: basic first aid, boat safety, Virginia fishing regulations, fish conservation, and boat navigation. We depart the Marina and each child is coached on how to fish with their own fishing rod and reel. Our day concludes with a picnic lunch and the awarding of the prizes for the Essays. This years Essay topic deals with what each individual can do to improve the Bay. This year's goal is to take 300 or more youngsters from multiple resource groups, and their chaperones, for a day on the Bay.							
EXPECTED BENEFITS: We hope to instill a deep appreciation of Virginia's natural resources and the important role each person has in protecting those resources. We use current information available from the state to educate each youth. We try to use the fishing rules to connect the adherences to these rules to protecting the environment. We demonstrate that we operate our Charter business in full compliance with the rules to protect the environment, conserve Bay fisheries, and provide a safe fishing experience. Our goal is to educate these youngsters about how important it is to respect and preserve the environment.
